



BLUE CARD COMMAND CHECK OFF Train the Trainer



Blue Card Command Check Off classes now available at the NEFC Command Training Center. The check off and class consists of 24 hours made up of 3 - 8 hour days where students will learn or sharpen their Hazard Zone Management skills. Students will review and discuss from start to finish all of the components of hazard zone management to include the 8 Functions of Command, Initial on scene reports, Critical Fire-ground factors, Developing Incident Action Plans, Risk Analysis, Declaring Strategy, Review Evaluation and Revision of Incident Action Plans, and Transferring / Continuing Command. In addition to the classroom session students will be involved in simulations where they will be in every position from the 1st arriving

company who establishes command to the 4th arriving company to the Strategic Incident Commander. Every student will be directly involved in over 60 simulations on 5 different occupancy types. Students will leave the training with a greater understanding of **Hazard Zone Management**. The simulations create a great learning environment where if mistakes are made, lessons can be learned and personnel are not at jeopardy unlike the live fire-ground. Students must have completed the 50 hour online portion prior to signing up for Classroom and Check off Sessions.
